SCHEME OF DELEGATION

1. Purpose

- 1.1 To approve the updated Scheme of Delegation, giving effect to the revised Committee structure from July 2010.

2. Background

- 2.1 At its September 2009 meeting the Police Authority agreed to revise the Committee and Panel structure, reducing the overall number of meetings and enabling Members to more efficiently drive the business of the Authority including the production and performance monitoring of the Policing Plan.
- 2.2 At its meeting in December 2009 the Authority received the Terms of References (ToRs) for the new Committees and it was agreed that these would be included in a revised Scheme of Delegation for approval at this meeting.

3. Revised Scheme of Delegation

- 3.1 The Revised Scheme is attached to this report. It is a key document in the overall governance framework of the Authority and Constabulary.
- 3.2 Some further changes have been made to the Terms of Reference and the opportunity has been taken to overhaul the Scheme and update it where necessary. These changes are considered to be minor.

- 4.1 The Authority is asked to approve the updated Scheme of Delegation.
